# CONSTITUTION (AMENDMENT) (DUAL CITIZENSHIP) ACT 2018

## **1 Short title**

This Act may be cited as the *Constitution (Amendment) (Dual Citizenship) Act 2018*.

## **2 Commencement**

This Act commences on the day appointed by the Minister by notice in the *Gazette*.

## **3 Repeal of section 23**

Section 23 of the Constitution is repealed.

## **4 Amendment of section 49**

Section 49(1)(a) of the Constitution is amended by inserting the following after “state”:

“, including by holding citizenship of a country other than Solomon Islands;”
