Paragraph 11

Insert the following text at the end of the paragraph: "Nevertheless, the Working Group wished to express its gratitude to the Canadian Government for its written reply concerning the reasons why it had not ratified the 1949 Convention. Canada stated that it gave priority to the questions of child prostitution and violence against women. In its view, however, the provisions of the 1949 Convention no longer reflected the reality of trafficking in persons and more recent instruments were able to combat those practices more effectively".

Paragraph 17

Insert the following text at the end of the paragraph: "The members of the Working Group also had before them a brochure on the implementation of the programme of action submitted by the Indian Government, entitled 'Child labour/Challenge and response'".
