The Permanent Mission of the Kingdom of Nepal to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1373 (2001) concerning counter-terrorism and, with reference to the latter's letter dated 31 May 2006 regarding the fourth report of Nepal (S/2005/442), has the honour to submit for the kind consideration of the Committee that it provide the following assistance to the Government of Nepal under section 3 of the letter.

For the Department of Immigration

- Technology to examine forged papers and documents at immigration entry and exit points and training to the officials concerned on the above subject
- Computer networking at different immigration entry and exit points

For Police Headquarters

- Training in counter-terrorism
- Training in combating money-laundering and financing of terrorism

For the Armed Police Force Headquarters

- (a) Border Security
 - Equipment and logistics and necessary training to security people
 - Vehicles
 - Training to examine suspicious objects
 - Canine unit
- (b) Air safety
 - Computer data system and networking
 - Closed caption television networking
 - Explosive materials test techniques
 - Providing communication equipment and vehicles
- (c) Control and investigation of terrorism movement
 - Equipment, training assistance and research laboratory on cybercrimes and financial crimes
- (d) To develop an integrated mechanism to maintain coordination between the various agencies dealing with control of terrorism

For the Ministry of Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs

- Drafting of legislation related to the prevention and suppression of terrorism
- Orientation for judges and administrators who deal with terrorism-related cases

The Mission has the honour to further inform the Committee that it will forward the necessary comments on other comments and questions raised in the Chairman's letter as soon as they are available.
