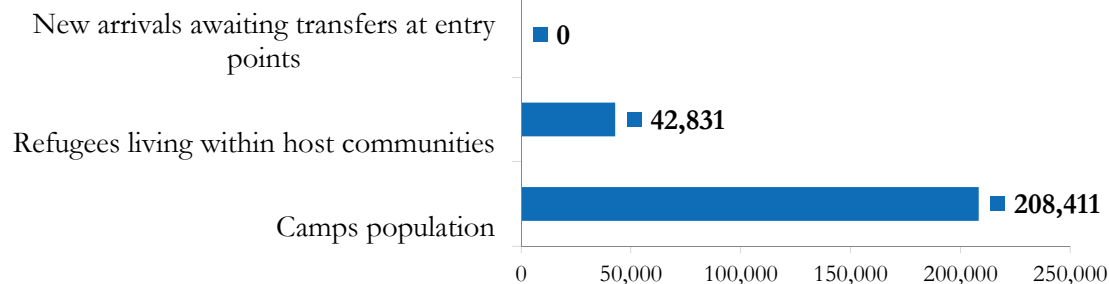


South Sudanese refugee population in Gambella (as of 27-February-2015)

Refugee population Breakdown

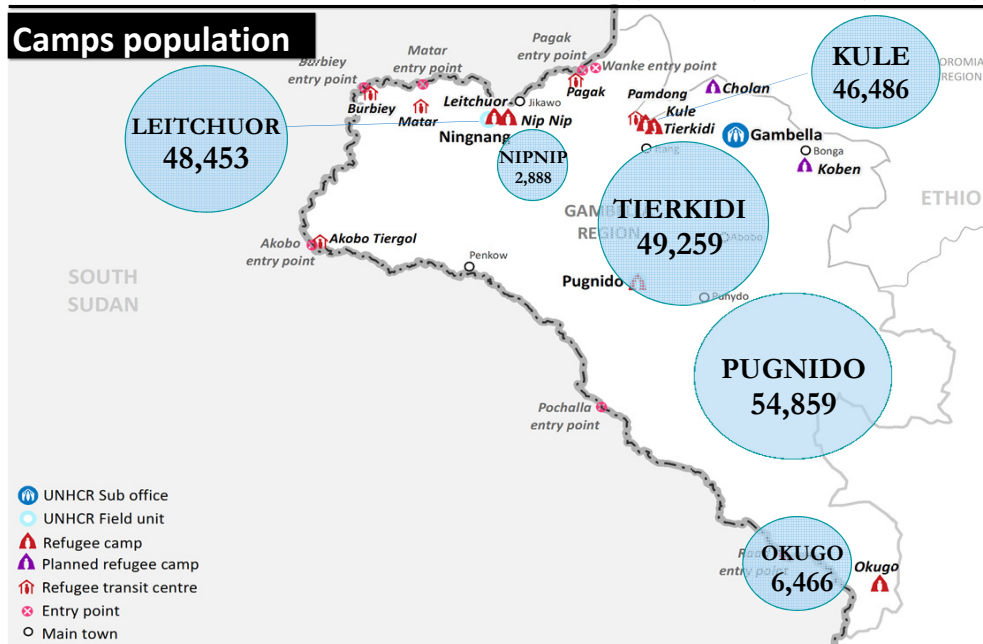

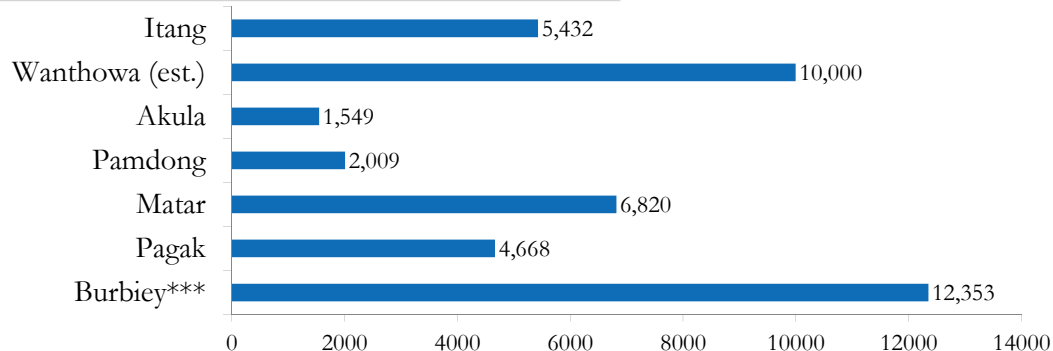
