

**Order of the Federal Government,
according to which States are to be deemed safe countries of origin
(Country of Origin Regulation – HStV)**

Issued on 16th June 2009

The following regulation is issued pursuant to Article 19(5)(2) of the Federal Office Procedures Act, Federal Law Gazette (FLG) I No 87/2012, last amended by federal law FLG I No. 84/2015:

Article 1. The following States are to be deemed safe countries of origin:

1. Bosnia and Herzegovina;
2. Kosovo;
3. Mongolia;
4. Macedonia;
5. Montenegro;
6. Serbia;
7. Albania;
8. Ghana;
9. Morocco;
10. Algeria;
11. Tunisia;
12. Georgia.

Article 2.

- (1) The present Order shall enter into force on 1 July 2009.
- (2) Article 1(7) as amended by federal act FLG II No. 428/2010, shall enter into force at midnight on 14th December 2010.
- (3) The preamble as amended by federal act FLG II No. 405/2013, shall enter into force at midnight on 31st December 2013.
- (4) Article 1(3) and (8)-(12) as amended by federal act FLG II No. 47/2016, shall enter into force at midnight on 16th February 2016.
