Paragraph 59

For the existing text *substitute*

The legislation of the following 15 States allows the application of the death penalty to children: India (Jammu and Kashmir), the Islamic Republic of Iran, the Lao People's Democratic Republic, Malaysia, Maldives, Mauritania, Nigeria, Pakistan, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Somalia, the State of Palestine, Tonga, the United Arab Emirates and Yemen. During the reporting period, at least four States, namely the Islamic Republic of Iran, Saudi Arabia, the State of Palestine (Gaza) and Yemen, executed children.
